Basketball is played on a rectangular court. A professional basketball court is 94 feet (28.7 meters) long and 50 feet (15.2 meters) wide. High school and international courts may be slightly smaller. Each end of the court has a basket. The basket is a metal ring with a net hanging from the rim. It is attached to a backboard, which is usually made of strong glass. The rim of the basket is 10 feet (3 meters) above the floor of the court. A basketball is round and full of air, which makes it bounce well.
